NON-REPORTING: HOW TO OBTAIN DRUG TEST RESULTS

You have chosen to submit urine and/or blood samples for the purpose of testing for the presence of substances which may have been used to facilitate a sexual assault. You have also chosen to not make a report to law enforcement at this time. Your samples will be sent to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) for testing.

- Your test results will be available in approximately 4 to 8 weeks.
- To obtain the test results, you must contact the CDPHE lab directly by calling 303-692-3680. CDPHE lab staff will tell you the results over the phone. At this time, test results are available in English only.
- This number is for the main toxicology department and is only open between the hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
- You must provide your date of birth and case number (at the top of this page) to obtain your results. These results will be available only to you.
- CDPHE will store the samples for one year and the results six years.
- You can request a hard copy of your test results, and CDPHE can email or fax them to you upon request.
- Once you receive your test results, it is your choice as to whether or not you would like to open a case with law enforcement.
- You should not receive a bill for the drug testing. If you receive one in error, please contact the Division of Criminal Justice at 303-239-5719.

We recommend that you keep this paperwork in a confidential and secure location.
