According to the National Sexual Violence Resource Center and The National Intimate Partner and Sexual Violence Survey, **1 in 5 women and 1 in 71 men** will be rape at some point in their life.

1 in 4 women and 1 in 6 men are sexually abused before the age of 18.

1 in 5 women and one in 16 men are sexually assaulted while in College.

Persons with disabilities are sexually assaulted **at rates more than twice** the rate for persons without a disability.

Over 50% of transgender individuals are survivors of sexual violence.
